

## Carers Link 100 Club: Terms & Conditions



1. Participation in this lottery is open to all supporters of Carers Link (including Carers Link Board members, staff and volunteers).
2. For the foreseeable future all proceeds from Carers Link's 100 Club will support one of our carer groups in East Dunbartonshire. Carers Link reserves the right to allocate funding to another carer support service should groups no longer require additional funds.
3. The cost per month will be £5.00 per entry. Any participant can hold one or more entries.
4. Entries are payable by standing order mandate or yearly in advance. Payments must be received no later than the 25th of the month to participate in the following month's draw.
5. To set up a regular payment to Carers Link please use the following bank details and use your name and CL 100 club as a reference:

6. Each entry will be allocated a number. A record of names and numbers will be kept at the Carers Link office in Milngavie, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations and Carers Link's Privacy and Data Protection policies (copies available on request).
7. Draws will be held on the second Wednesday of each month. The draw will be made by someone who does not participate in the lottery, under the auspices of Carers Link's fundraising manager and at least two other Carers Link representatives.
8. The prize fund will be 50% of the total number of entries paid for, distributed between six prizes. First prize will be 20%, second prize 10%, and third to sixth prize 5% of funds raised the previous month's entries.
9. Prize winners will be informed as soon as possible after the draw by letter, telephone, text or email. We will live stream the draw on Facebook, and then the list of winners will be announced on Carers Link's website and on social media.
10. It is possible to withdraw at any time, simply cancel your payment with your bank. You must also inform Carers Link.
11. Carers Link will not be responsible for any bank charges incurred by participants in the administration of their standing order mandate. It is the responsibility of each participant to ensure you have sufficient funds available when payment is due.
